COLLEGE PROFESSOR HONORED FOR TEACHING EXCELLENCE

Dr. Dhiman was chosen as the International Teaching Excellence Award recipient from the eight regional winners. Dr. Dhiman was honored at the ACBSP 2004 Annual Conference in Phoenix, Arizona on June 27, 2004. As regional winner for the Region 7 - Western U.S. Region, Dr. Dhiman was selected from among all ACBSP member institutions throughout Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, Oregon, Utah, Washington, and Wyoming.
